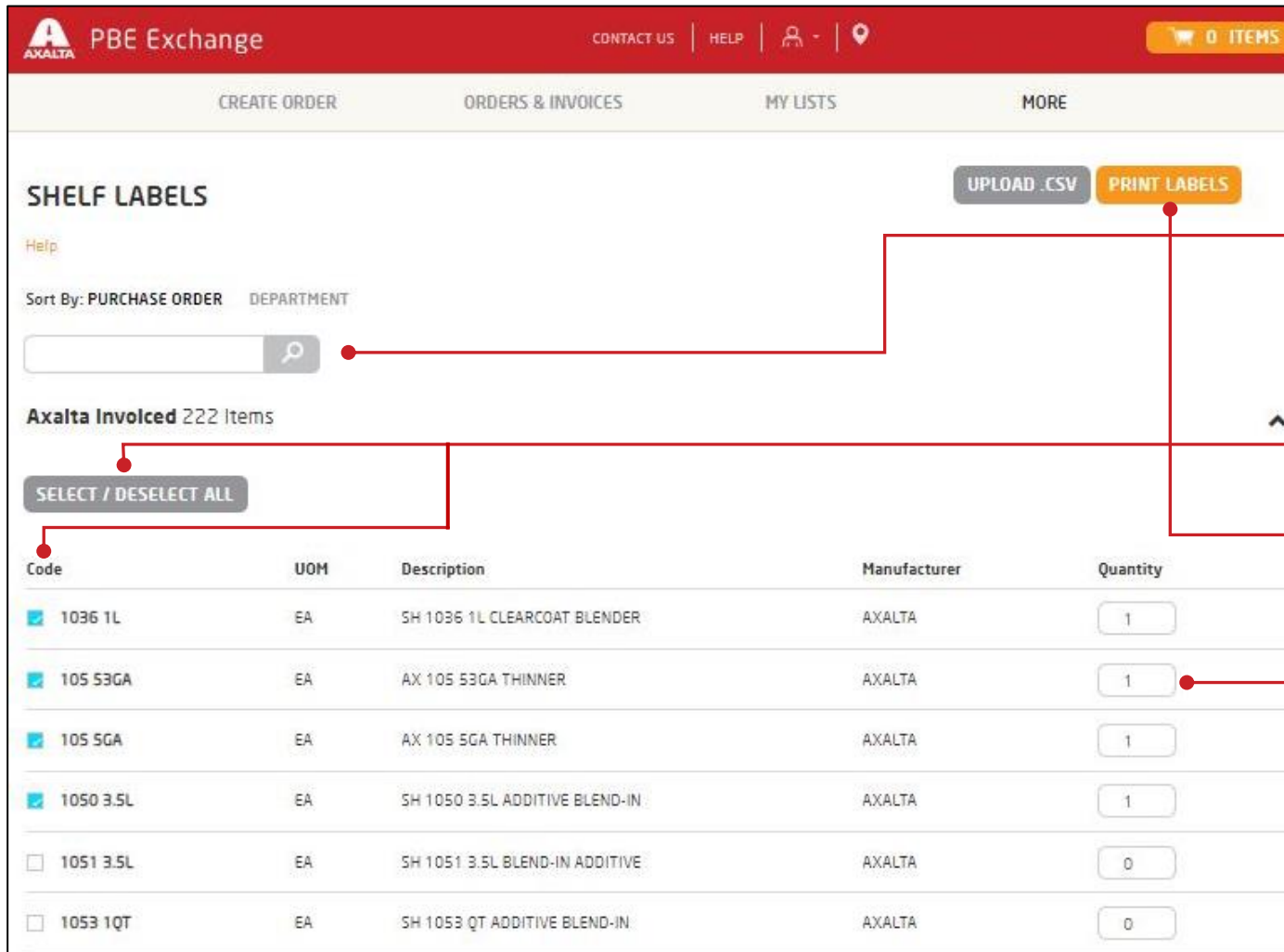
How it Works

QR Codes can be scanned with the PBE Exchange Mobile App to quickly add products to your shopping cart. QR Codes shelf labels can be created for all catalog products and PBE Exchange supports printing on Avery 5161, Dymo and Brother labels.

QR Code Shelf Labels



From the PBE Exchange home page, click **More** in the header, then click **Shelf Labels** in the fly out menu.



NOTE: All products in your catalog(s) are listed and available for creating shelf labels.

To search for a specific product, go to the search field, type a product number and click the spyglass.

To make a product selection, either click **Select/Deselect All** or mark a product's checkbox under the **Code** column.

Next, go to the **Quantity** column to type your amount or click the up or down arrows.

When finished, click **Print Labels** to generate your QR Code shelf labels.

From the **Select Output Type** window, mark your label preference.

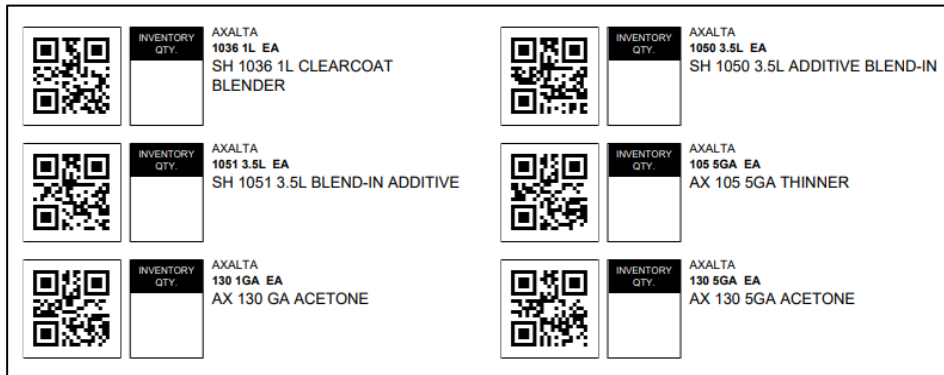
When finished, click **OK**.
